Biodegradable: a material that can be broken down with the help of micro-organisms, returning the materials to the natural environment, without leaving plastic waste behind. Choosing biodegradable baby products is one way to help the environment.

Compostable: the process of breaking down organic waste, in order to eventually reuse it. For example, as fertiliser.

Non-flushable: you can't flush the product down a toilet to dispose of it. An easy way to find out is to look out for this icon which is found on packaging.

Did you know, that with every pack of WaterWipes biodegradable wipes, you are saving the equivalent of 6 single use plastic carrier bags?** **Organic:** the product is made without any artificial ingredients. For example, organic baby food.

Recycling: the process of taking materials, such as plastic or glass, ready to be thrown away and changing them into reusable ones.

Sustainable: using resources in a way that they can continue to be available in the future.

Vegan friendly: when the product does not contain any animal ingredients or animal-derived ingredients. For example, vegan food wraps, which are a plant based, vegan alternative to cling film.

Zero waste lifestyle: means you use as little single-use plastic as possible – opting for sustainable and reusable alternatives that don't harm the environment. For example, wooden toys.
